Condition	Some customers may comment after a soaking rain or car wash if they drive at highway speeds with the HVAC off they can hear a gurgling noise. This noise could be coming from the left or right front sunroof drains.
Cause	Residual water still in the sunroof drains.

Correction:

To help clear the residual water from the sunroof drains, turn on the HVAC blower and set the recirculation door to fresh air mode. This will clear any residual water from the sunroof drain tubes.
